The National Design Policy had recommended setting up design institutes on the lines of NID, Ahmedabad in various parts of India to promote design programmes. Under this Action Plan, 4 new NIDs and Madhya Pradesh (Bhopal) is one of them.

Establishing new NIDs as Institutions of National Importance Established by Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Government of India under an act of parliament National Institute of Design (Amendment) Act 2019, will contribute to the development of highly competent designer in many parts of the nation, creating both direct and indirect job opportunities, by providing sustainable design interventions for crafts, handloom, rural technology, small, medium, and large-scale enterprises; and outreach programs for capacity, capability, and institution building.

The institute commenced academic activities in the academic year 2019–20. NID MP currently offers a “Bachelor’s Degree in Design” (B. Design) in the fields of Industrial, Communication, and Textile and Apparel Design and interdisciplinary studies.

The first batch of students shall be graduating in 2023.

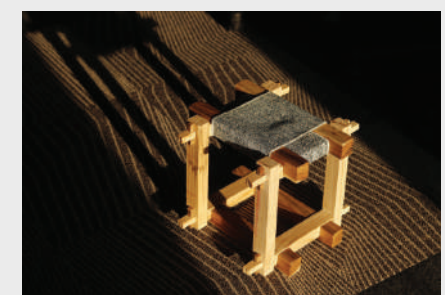
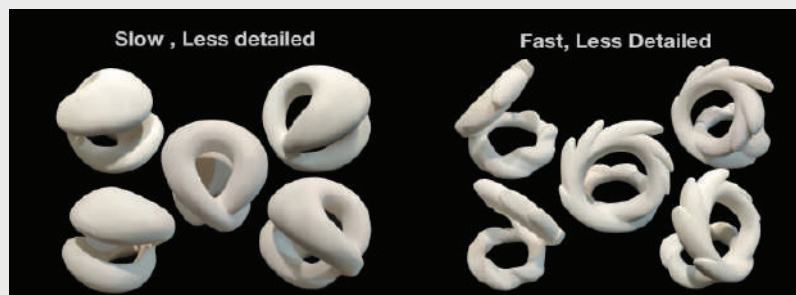
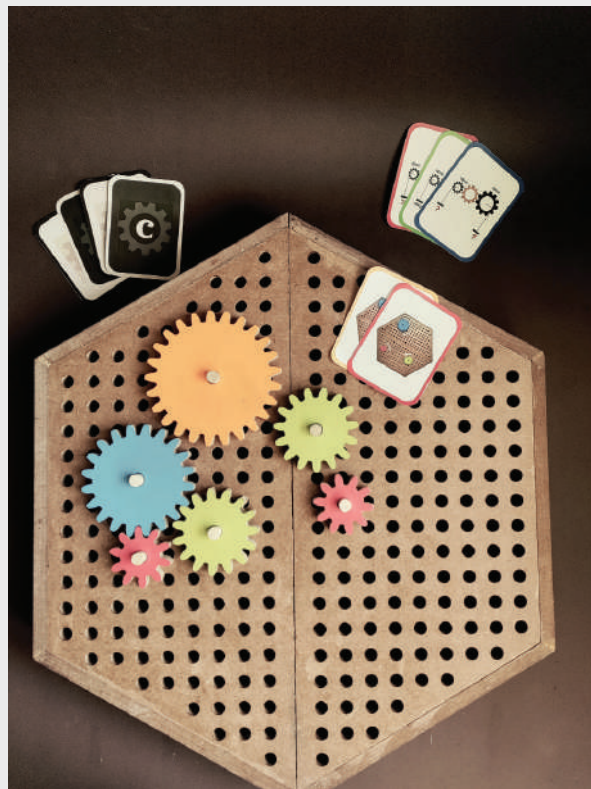
INDUSTRIAL DESIGN

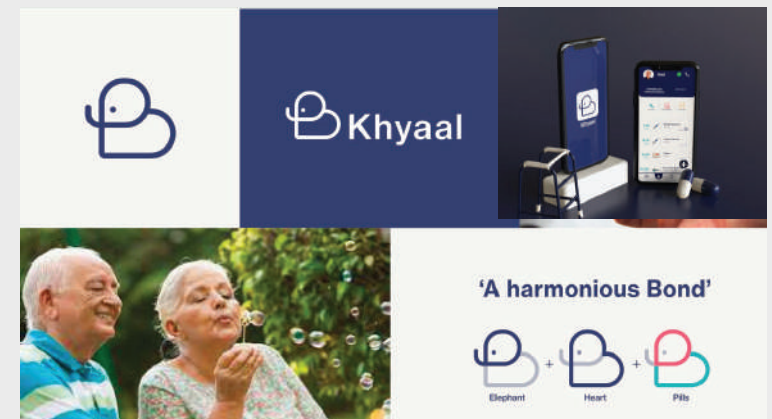
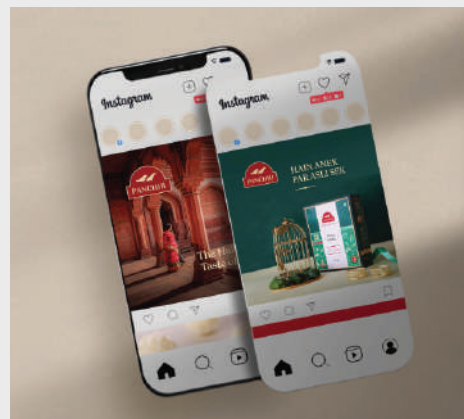
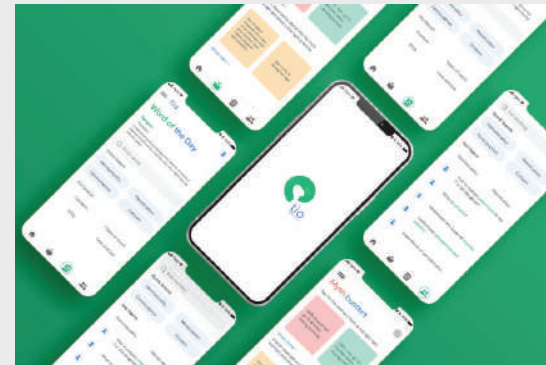
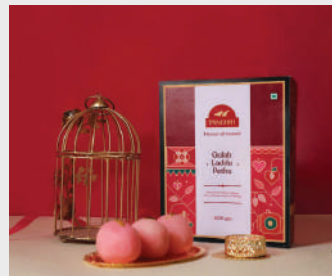


COMMUNICATION DESIGN

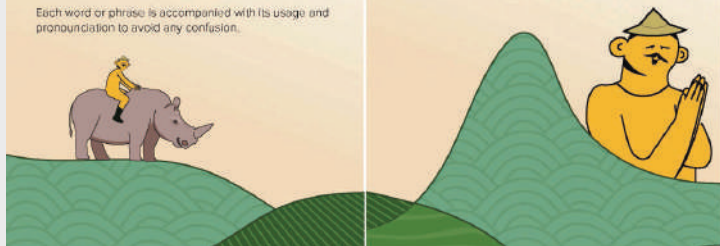

Excuse me Ajuhat/mo

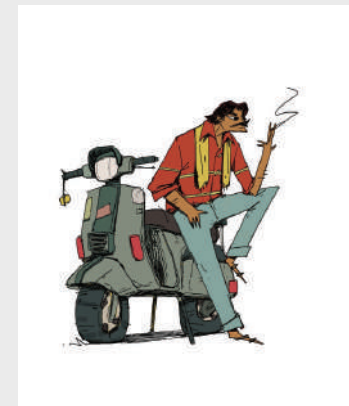
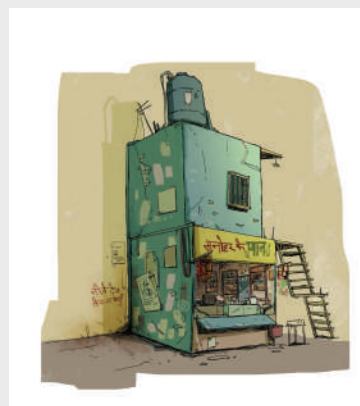
As in any culture, being polite and respectful is appreciated. People are also free to mean nothing to you if you with your speaking will not be confused with your language. If you want your message, write it down.

This simple sentence could equally save the day in any given situation.

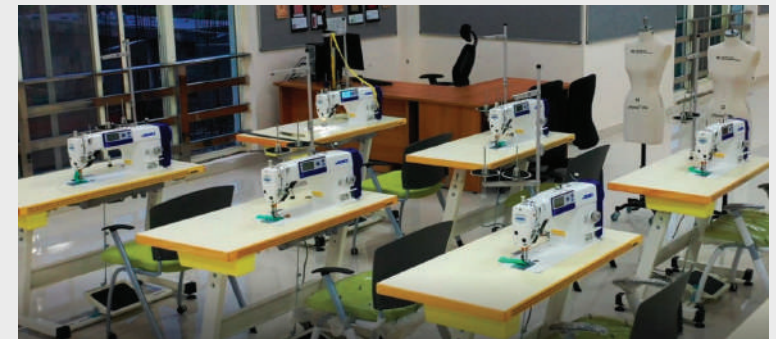
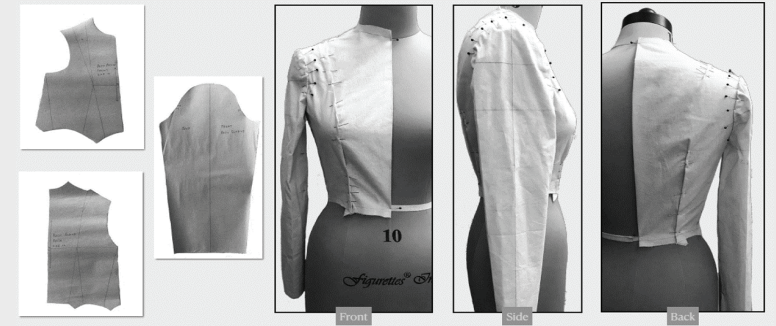


TEXTILE & APPAREL DESIGN

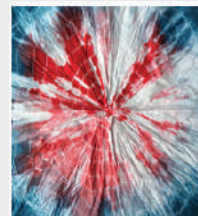

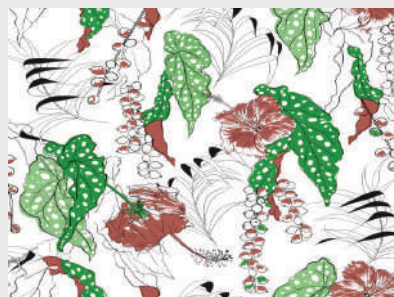

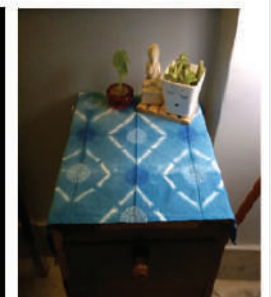
