ADMISSIONS – FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs)

Q1. What type of programme and duration are offered by NID Madhya Pradesh?

The National Institute of Design, Madhya Pradesh offers a four-year Bachelor of Design (B.Des.) programme in the following disciplines:

- a) Industrial Design
- b) Communication Design
- c) Textile and Apparel Design

Q2. What is the admission procedure and programme duration?

Admission to the four-year B.Des. programme is based on the Design Aptitude Test (DAT), which consists of:

- a) DAT Prelims &
- b) DAT Mains Examination (Studio Sensitivity test & In Person Sensitivity test) .

Q3. What is the medium of instruction?

The B.Des. programme is currently being offered in English medium only.

Q4. Is the Institute recognized by UGC/AICTE?

The National Institute of Design, Madhya Pradesh (NID MP) is an Institute of National Importance (INI) functioning as an autonomous institute under the Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Government of India.

Q5. What facilities are available on campus for students?

The Institute provides a wide range of academic and student support facilities, including:

- a) Classrooms/Studios/Lab spaces of Academic Building duly equipped with Central HVAC System and Audio-Video cum Presentation System.
- b) Messing Facility with Airconditioned Dining Hall
- c) Workshops, Laboratories, and Design Studios
- d) IT Lab
- e) Library and Resource Centre
- f) Auditorium
- g) Amphitheatre
- h) Cafeteria outlets (set-up & run through Amul and Nescafé)
- i) Multifacility Recreational Centre including Gymnasium

- j) Indoor and Outdoor Sports Facilities (Football, Volleyball, Basketball Courts, Lawn Tennis Courts, Table Tennis, Cricket practice pitch, Carrom, Chess etc.)
- k) Basic Medical Facility, visiting Doctors, nursing staff and Emergency Ambulance Services
- l) Hostel facilities along with Sick Room, Common Rooms with TV, OTT Subscriptions, Common Fridge, RO Units, Water Dispensers & Washing Machines. Each room is provided with furniture items namely 01 cot with mattress, 01 bed-side table, 01 study table with revolving chair and 01 lockable wooden cupboard.
- m) Campus facilities with professional security staff and CCTV surveillance systems.
- n) Group Mediclaim Insurance including Accidental Insurances for students
- o) Student Counselling and Psychological Support
- p) Internet/Wi-Fi Services
- q) Emergency Power Backup through DG Sets
- r) Operational Lifts / Elevators at Academic Block & Hostels for ease of vertical circulation.
- s) Centrally operated Water Treatment Plant
- t) Open Gymnasium
- u) Bicycle Facilities
- v) Basic Stationery Shop with Printing Facility
- w) Weekend Bus Facility to Bhopal City (Started from Mar 2026 on a trial basis)

Q6. Are hostel facilities available for students?

NID Madhya Pradesh offers a full-time residential education programme. The Institute has two separate hostel blocks, one for boys and one for girls. Each hostel room Further details regarding hostel facilities are available on the Institute's official website.

Q8. What is the scope of Design education?

Design education provides students with creative, analytical, and problem-solving skills that are highly valued across various industries. Graduates in design can pursue careers in fields such as product design, communication design, textile and apparel design, user experience (UX/UI), branding, advertising, animation, film and media, craft development, and entrepreneurship.

Design professionals may work with design studios, manufacturing industries, technology companies, media and advertising agencies, fashion and textile sectors, research organizations, and government initiatives. Additionally, graduates may choose to pursue higher studies, independent practice or start their own design ventures.

Q9. Is there any training and placement support provided by NID Madhya Pradesh?

NID Madhya Pradesh has a dedicated Training and Placement Cell that facilitates industry interaction, internship and placement support for students. The cell functions under the guidance of experienced faculty members, helping students connect with leading organizations and professionals in the design sector.
